Church gatherings, the next step: we agreed to move forward as a fellowship in developing three ministries initially. These three possible developments were the most talked about during the gatherings held in January. Youth work: the key this for this meeting will be making sure we have at the very least a structure for how we will set up the YF and when we will start it. Other than that, we'll talk about strategies to encourage more youth into the YF once it is set up, what events we can do, including working with other churches and other Christian organisations (for example Scripture Union).
