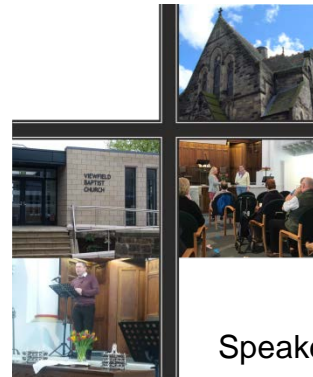

PASSION PLAY (OBERAMMERGAU 2020)

The world famous Passion Play is a once-in-a decade performance commemorating Christ's journey into Jerusalem, His death and resurrection. It takes place in Oberammergau in Bavaria, Germany and will be performed again in 2020 from 16th May until 4th October. The performance involves more than 2000 villagers of Oberammergau and lasts 8 hours with a 3 hour lunch break.

I have found a deal for the trip to the Passion Play -5 days travelling on 4th June 2020 for £979 + local flight supplement of approx £50. Optional entry fees to castles and tours etc of up to £75.
