The world famous Passion Play is a once-in-a decade performance commemorating Christ's journey into Jerusalem, death and resurrection, held in Oberammergau, Bavaria, Germany from 16th May until 4th October 2020. The performance involves more than 2000 local villagers and lasts 8 hours with a 3 hour lunch break.
