Financial Support for Viewfield

Over the last year we have seen a steady increase in our donation income, with the total for 2018-19 being 24% higher than 2017-18. At the March Church Meeting we agreed that we want to be able to expand our ministries and reach out more to our community, so we adopted a budget which required a further 32% increase in donation income. That may seem very challenging, but based on the income received in April, we have already achieved a 13% increase in monthly income compared to 2018-19. If you are a UK tax payer, your giving can be increased by 25% at no extra cost to yourself by using the Gift Aid Scheme.

Notice from Church Meeting

At the church meeting on Wednesday 24th April we unanimously agreed to amend the constitution to allow us to change our charitable status to a Scottish Charitable Incorporated Organisation (SCIO), and after a time of feedback we agreed in principle:

1. to install Soft Play equipment, a Sensory Room and Community Café in the Hall
2. to employ a Children and Families Worker (part time or full time)
3. to provide a drop-in facility for vulnerable people, possibly in partnership with an agency such as Bethany Christian Trust

The Deacons will carry out further research to investigate costings, possible grants and other implications of the above proposals, which will be presented at a future Church Meeting for discussion and agreement.
