### Study Questions

3. Discuss the importance of lament within Christian worship? Why is honest expression so important in your relationship with God?
4. “Turn your worry time into prayer time.” Consider this statement.
5. Consider your prayer life? In what ways could you deepen your prayer life?
6. Matthew Henry says: *“To cast our cares upon God, is to rest upon his providence and promise.”* What comfort does it bring when you consider the providence of God?
7. Describe some of the ways the faithfulness of God is demonstrated in our life's?
8. Are there times when you have felt let down by God?
9. At the end of the Psalm David affirms his trust in God. In what ways can we exercise our trust in God?
