- Pray for Healthcare workers ([www.cmf.org.uk/resources/covid-19-resources](http://www.cmf.org.uk/resources/covid-19-resources))
  - Give thanks for the many in the caring professions who have worked long hours and sacrificially to care for others during the pandemic.
  - Please pray for those who are:
    - fearful and anxious for their own health on the frontline and for the health of those who live with them.
    - facing death and illness of patients and colleagues.
    - dealing with fear, anxiety and panic of patients and colleagues.
    - in senior positions who carry the responsibility for making difficult decisions which will have life and death consequences.
    - having to work away from home or in new positions and feeling ill equipped and out of their comfort zones.
  - Pray that every day as they care for the sick in this time of crisis, they would know the peace of the Lord which transcends all understanding to fill their hearts and minds in Christ Jesus (Philippians 4:7)
  - Pray that they would depend on the equipping and empowering of the Lord each day for the strength they need in caring for the sick, and for them to remember that the Lord's mercies are new every morning (Lamentations 3:22-23)
