### Operation Chad - BMS Harvest Appeal

At our Harvest Service on 27 September, we  
heard about the BMS Harvest Appeal - Operation  
Chad - to support the work of a BMS supported  
hospital in Chad. Following that service, we  
received donations totalling a little over £1,000  
through Viewfield Funds. Some of these will have  
Gift Aid claimed on them, so we expect to be  
passing on at least £1,200 to BMS. This total is  
close to double the amount we have received for  
our Harvest Appeal in recent years and, of
