Vision Romania – Update - visionromania.org – Jim & Margaret Leiper

Vision Romania are organising outdoor events for children in approx 8 villages in the outskirts of Hunedoara which will be delivered by our partners (led by Dani Hritac). We will fund the outings (food, games, crafts, sketches, songs, Bible stories etc) and altogether there will be nearly 200 kids involved.

We are organising similar events via our other partner Elena Pleter (along with Maria and Giani Rus, 2 of our Romanian Vision Romania Trustees) for youngsters with disabilities with in the region of 50 people will be involved in this.

We are also providing funding to ‘Autism Meda’ for Dana Truta (our Partner for this organisation) for the benefit of the children with Autism attending the centre in Hunedoara.

All of this is in addition to the monthly food drop to the community of families living in shacks on the outskirts of the city and the routine input to the local orphanage in Hunedoara.

Prayers appreciated for the safety of all of these activities taking place with COVID precautions.

The programmes have already started and have been enjoyed by everyone attending.

Brexit’s significant negative impact on the enrolment of international students has limited their access for only six months. This along with other matters have been a major concern as Tilsley looks to the future.

In response, Tilsley’s staff team will be working hard over the coming year to find a pathway for international students to study residentially alongside others from the UK for their mutual benefit. The aim being to see them all better equipped to serve in our



increasingly cosmopolitan societies. Tilsley College will be initiating developments over the coming year to strengthen their online presence in the shape of “Tilsley Academy”, where the plan is to offer self-directed online training that will be accessible for people of all abilities who are not able to take time out for an extended online programme. This web-based training will also provide on-field and in-location development training for Christian workers, missionaries and church leaders. So as to give staff time to implement changes it has been agreed to pause the student intake to the Certificate of Higher Education in Biblical Studies and Christian Ministry.

Please pray for Georgette and the other staff as they work on the plans outlined above. Please also pray for the students who have just graduated and especially for Jenny as she adjusts to being back at work.



Port St Mary SU Beach Mission: The partial opening of the Manx borders took place on the 28th of June. Those who have 2 Covid Vaccine injections at least 2 weeks before travel are allowed to enter the Island without requiring any quarantine or tests. David and Evelyn, Alistair and Rhona with Nathan & Craig will be able to travel as will Alison, but not Jon. Gillian Downey is not able to come now.

Please pray that there may be further loosening of restrictions (currently children 5 to 18 are allowed entry but need to take a covid test and are isolated until the test is negative).
