To put the Core Values into action we have a number of Ministries:

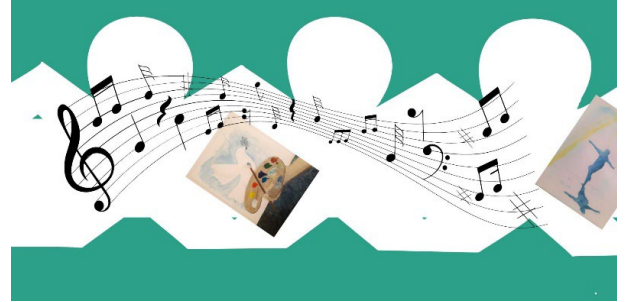
*The Westminster catechism says:*
