Pray for church leaders on the ground in Ukraine and neighbouring countries providing safe havens for refugees.

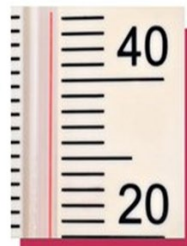
Pray that the Lord will sustain them and that many people will find respite and refuge through their hard work.
