Project Fund Progress

We are delighted to report that we received notification this week of a £5,000 grant from the Carnegie Trust. Also in the last couple of weeks we received grants of £3,000 from the Souter Foundation, and £1,000 from the Russell Trust. Putting these together with the generous giving of the congregation, including regular and promised donations, means that we will have at least £44,000 by September. This is two thirds of the target for the Soft Play, Sensory Room and Community Café Project. Applications have been submitted to several other Trusts and we await their response.
