Project Fund Progress

We have received exciting news this week of another grant towards the Soft Play, Sensory Room and Community Café Project. The Hugh Fraser Foundation have promised us £5,000. This comes in addition to the recent awards of £5,000 from the Carnegie Trust, £3,000 from the Souter Foundation, and £1,000 from the Russell Trust. Putting these together with the generous giving of the congregation, including regular and promised donations, means that we will have at least £49,000 by September. This is 74% of the target for the Soft Play, Sensory Room and Community Café Project. Applications have been submitted to several other Trusts and we await their response.
