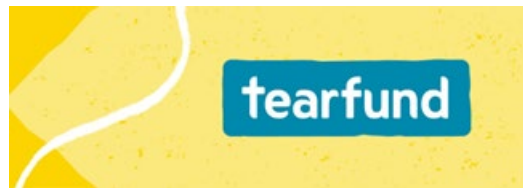


Ukraine Refugees - Vision Romania
